The family of Armand J. LeBlanc conjointly with the Bedford Lion's Club will award one \$2,500 scholarship per year (Multiple scholarships may be awarded as funds are available. The number of scholarships, and the amount of each scholarship, will be announced at the beginning of the application process).

Applicants must reside in the Greater Manchester, New Hampshire area and have a career interest in the trade fields of Plumbing, Electrical or Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (H.V.A.C.) fields. Prior recipients of the Armand J. LeBlanc Trade Scholarship are not eligible.



In addition to a monetary award there will be an opportunity for an HVAC internship with A.J. LeBlanc Heating Company
